Welcome to the Three Crowns

The Three Crowns, once an old manor house belonging to Sir John Whyddon, was described by famous clergyman and writer, Charles Kingsley as 'a beautiful old mullioned and gabled perpendicular inn' and in 1952 was registered as a building of historical and architectural interest.

Built of Dartmoor granite in the 13th century, the Three Crowns retains an old world atmosphere but now boasts all the facilities required by a 21st century customer.

It was in our stone porch that young Sidney Godolphin aged 32, cavalier and poet, and described as 'one of the four wheels of Charles 1st's wain,' was killed during a skirmish with the Roundheads in 1642. He died on one of the stone seats at the side of the porch.

To this day, it is rumoured that Sidney Godolphin occasionally walks along the corridors upstairs, always going up the stairs to the tower room above the porch.

Today, the Three Crowns has been completely refurbished whilst maintaining the period style and no expense has been spared in providing maximum comfort.

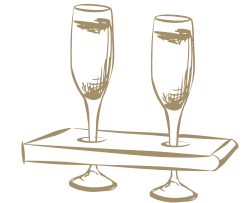
